

The Prophets

Prophets had to be called by God, often through dreams or visions. Many didn't want to obey their calling, but God didn't take NO for an answer. Prophets not only listened to God; they also asked Him to make things happen, like signs to prove to people that they were genuine prophets. They had to keep up with the times and be able to predict the future accurately.

Prophets taught people to love God and obey His commands. Prophets were often unpopular because they had to tell the people what they didn't want to hear. They also wore hair shirts. These were a sign of mourning – the prophet was in mourning for the people.
