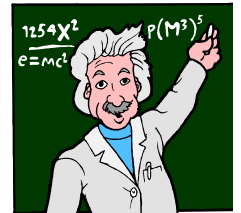

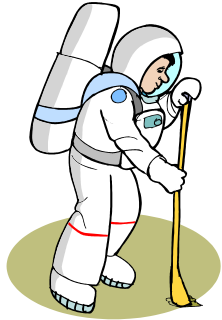


## General Knowledge – Year 6

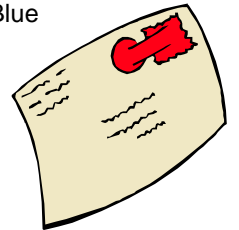
